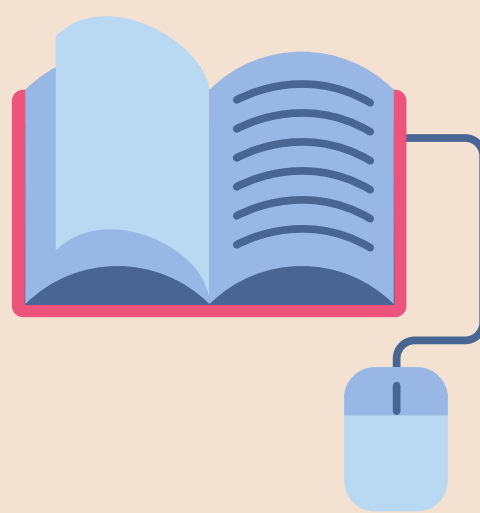


Description of the initiatives

- **LOST & FOUND** allowed students from Italy, France and Czech Republic to discuss in mixed groups the impact of the pandemic
- **eTwinning Toscana a distanza** provided teachers of all levels of educational institutions a space where they can continue their daily teaching with students
- **#everythingwillbefine** created a space where teachers and students could work together, but also have fun in a time of isolation
- **THE RED ZONE: Isolated but connected!** involved both the schools that were first closed and those who were still "OUT"
- **Desde casa le pongo freno** aimed at supporting students with a blog-like platform where they can share their passions, ask for advice etc.

Social impact of the initiatives

- Schools were provided an example of how distance learning can be engaging and effective
- Both students and teachers were able to learn new skills while interacting with "colleagues" from other countries
- Parents were relieved their children were not completely isolated during the lockdown season
